Nestled just 100 meters from the Turda Salt Mine, on the historic Durgău Hills, Crama La Salina carries on a winemaking tradition that dates back to the Roman Empire, when the area was known as Potaissa.

Revived after decades of silence, these Transylvanian hills have once again become home to thriving vineyards, shaped by modern viticulture and the unmistakable terroir of the Arieș Valley. The result is ISSA Wines – a tribute to the region's deep roots and to the timeless art of white wine.
